



Is your gender the same as you were assigned at birth?





Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition of the Equality Act?







6.1 If you went to University (to study a BA, BSc course or higher), were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?




6.2 Did you mainly attend a state or fee-paying school between the ages of 11-18?
